I hope this finds all of you doing well. There isn't anything to report on. However, there are 2 dates I would like to remind you about.



70.02 LIMITATIONS OF STOPPING AND PARKING

(A) No person shall stop or park a vehicle, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or traffic control device, in the front, side, street side, or rear of a residence, except with all four wheels on a hard surface of asphalt or concrete.

ORDINANCE SUMMARY ORDINANCE NO. 5, SERIES 2019-2020 AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO CABLE TELEVISION SERVICES


