Following are the Minutes of the July 2020 City Council Meeting for the City of St. Regis Park, held at 7:00 p.m., Tuesday, July 7, 2020 via ZOOM video conferencing.

ROLL CALL:

Present: John Amback, Donald Fountain, Craig Theis, Eric Shackelford, Louie Schweickhardt, Jeff Weis and Cheryl Willett.

Absent: Mayor Brandt Davis

MAYOR'S REPORT:

Mayor Davis was unable to attend the meeting and Mr. Shackelford made a motion to appoint Ms. Willett as Mayor pro-tem. The motion was seconded by Mr. Schweickhardt and it passed without dissent.

FINANCIAL REPORT:

The June 2020 financial report was presented by the city accountant, Mr. Charles J. Veeneman, CPA. Mr. Shackelford made a motion to approve the report. Mr. Weis seconded the motion and it passed without dissent. Copies of the financial reports are posted on the city website or can be requested from the city clerk.

MINUTES:

Mr. Amback made a motion to approve the June 2020 Minutes of the Regular Council Meeting. The motion was seconded by Mr. Shackleford and it passed without dissent.

ENGINEER'S REPORT

Mr. Mark Madison, the contracted city engineer recommended \$20,000.00 be allocated for the repair of several city sidewalks and street curbing. Mr. Amback made a motion to approve the funding. Mr. Shackleford seconded the motion and it passed without dissent.

Mr. Madison will mark the proposed the speed hump and sign locations on Lincoln Road and Dannywood Road to allow for council and resident review/comment.

FINANCE: JEFF WEIS

Mr. Weis stated that the May and June 2020 bank reconciliation was completed and there were no issues noted.


