Did You Know?

Placement Collection and Removal of Waste

- A) No garbage, grass or trash shall be placed at the curb side before 3:00 p.m., the day prior to pickup.
- (B) All garbage cans and items not collected shall be removed from the curb side by 7:00 p.m., the day of pickup.

PENALTY

Any person who shall violate any provision of 50.15 through 50.17 shall subject the offender to a civil penalty in an amount equal to two times the minimum fine prescribed herein, with a minimum civil penalty of \$50 for each violation.
