Following are the Minutes for the May 2026 City Council Meeting held at the Jeffersontown Fire Station #2.

Ms. Willet made a motion to approve the April 2026 financial report. The motion was seconded by Mr. Buckminster, and it passed without dissent.

Mr. Weis made a motion to approve the April 2026 meeting minutes. The motion was seconded by Mr. Neichter, and it passed without dissent.

Mr. Weis made a motion to approve the 1st reading of Ordinance 3, 2025-2026, an ordinance amending the FY 25-26 budget. The motion was seconded by Mr. Buckminster, and it passed without dissent.

Mr. Neichter made a motion to approve the 1st reading of Ordinance 1, 2026-2027, an ordinance establishing a property tax rate of .079 and an annual sanitation rate of \$359.52/household. The motion was seconded by Ms. Willett, and it passed without dissent.

Mr. Weis made a motion to approve the 1st Reading of Ordinance 2, 2026-2027, an ordinance establishing the FY26-27 budget. The motion was seconded by Mr. Buckminster, and it passed without dissent.

Mr. Buckminster made a motion to approve Resolution 1, 2026-2027, a resolution to enter into a Municipal Road Aid Agreement with the Commonwealth of Kentucky. Mr. Sanderfer seconded the motion, and it passed without dissent.

Mr. Sanderfer made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Mr. Neichter, and it passed without dissent. The meeting adjourned at 8:04pm

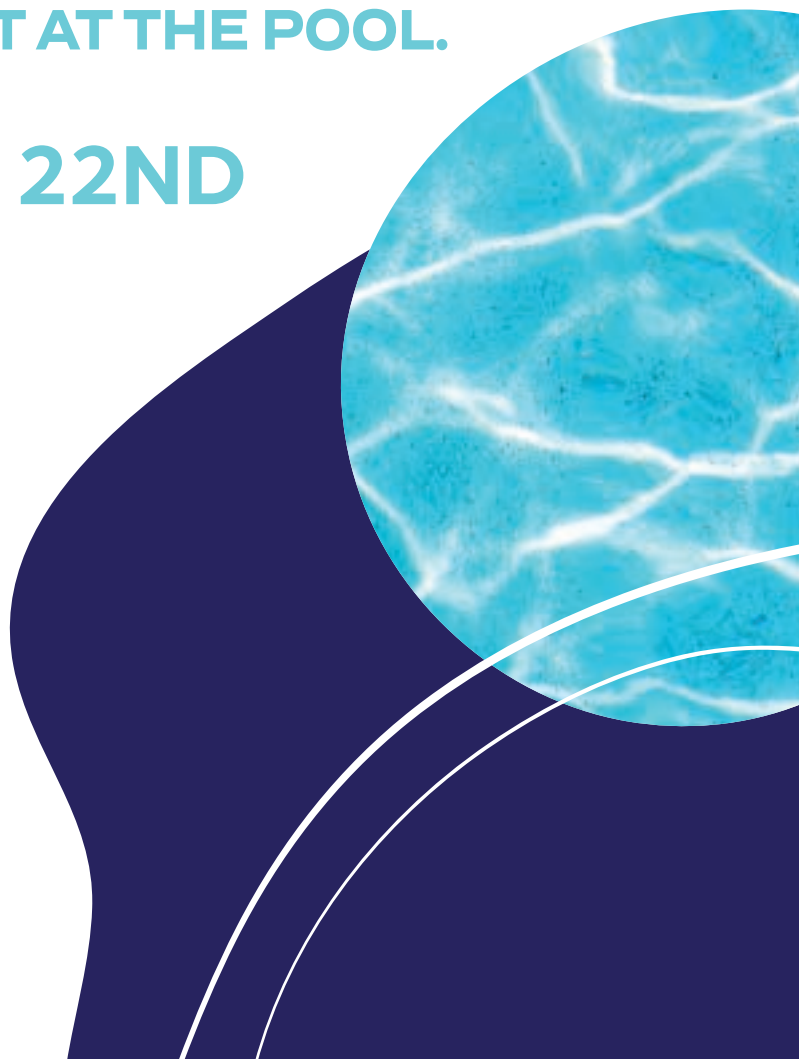

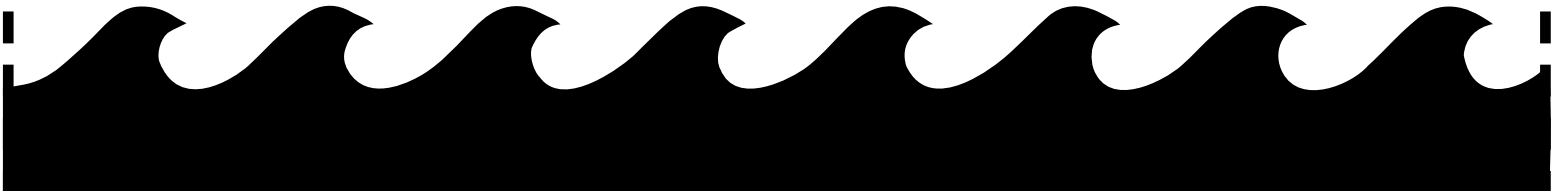
