During the January council meeting we discussed the Louisville Metro Department of Public Works new "Recycle Right" Program. Did You Know?

70.01 MANOR OF PARKING

(A) It shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to stop or park the vehicle in a manner other than with its right-hand side toward and parallel with the curb.

(B) No vehicle shall be parked or left standing on any street unless its two right wheels are within one foot of and parallel with the curb, except that on one-way streets where parking is permitted on the left side, the two left wheels are to be within one foot of and parallel with the curb.

70.02 LIMITATIONS OF STOPPING AND PARKING

(A) No person shall stop or park a vehicle, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or traffic control device, in the following places:

- (1) On a sidewalk or on a driveway blocking a sidewalk;*
- (2) In front of a sidewalk ramp providing for handicapped access;*
- (3) Within an intersection;*
- (7) Within 15 feet of each side of the approach to any fire hydrant;*
- (8) Any place the curb is painted red or yellow;*
- (9) In any manner that will affect the normal flow of traffic;*
- (11) In front of any public or private driveway;*
- (12) In the front, side, street side, or rear of a residence, except on a hard surface of asphalt or concrete;*

Did You Know?

Waste and Recycling in St Regis Park

Rumpke Recyclables

Paper/Cardboard - Newspapers, magazines, junk mail, cereal boxes, cardboard boxes (flattened), paperboard, cartons (milk, juice).

Plastics - Bottles, jugs, tubs (yogurt, sour cream), disposable cups.

Metal - Aluminum and steel cans.

Preparation - Rinse containers, reattach plastic lids, remove straws/stoppers, flatten boxes.

Bulk & Large Items Require Advance Scheduling (800-828-8171)

Furniture: Sofas, chairs, mattresses, box springs (must be wrapped in plastic).

Appliances: Refrigerators, washers (require refrigerant recovery statement for some).

What Rumpke Does NOT Take Curbside Trash

Hazardous Waste: Paint, chemicals, batteries, etc.

Electronics: TVs (unless under a certain size), computers.

Construction Debris: Drywall, concrete, dirt, rocks.

Styrofoam: Packing peanuts, foam cups/containers.

Plastic Bags/Film

Electronic Scrap (E-scrap) Recycling and Document Destruction
